- demonstrate familiarity with the origin and development of librarianship as a science and activity,

Assessment and completion

Students' knowledge is assessed by means of practical exercises and seminar papers, and also via products, projects, performances, services, etc. and by examinations. Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

In order to progress to the second year, students must have completed course units from the programme totalling 60 credits, which they are expected to complete in the first two semesters In order to progress to the third year, students must have completed course units from the programme totalling 120 credits, which they are expected to complete in the first four semesters.

Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete their studies, students must complete all course units prescribed by the programme and subject syllabuses, and write and defend a bachelor's thesis.
