#### **Learning outcomes**

The qualification holder will be able to:

**Admission requirements** 

- demonstrate technical knowledge acquired through the study of theoretical content and practical verification in a real and/or simulated environment,
- use modern tools and skills in everyday professional work, taking into account new methods, procedures and technologies,
- transfer theoretical knowledge into practice,
- build on basic knowledge from the course of study in practice,
- resolve problems through the use of new sources of information and the application of scientific methods,
- self-educate in own specialist field,
- demonstrate initiative and independence in decision-making and the performance of less demanding work consonant with their experience,
- experiment and implement experience and findings in practice,
- work as part of a team,
- cooperate with experts from adjacent fields in an interdisciplinary manner,
- communicate with non-experts,
- demonstrate an understanding of professional, ethical and environmental responsibility.

# **Assessment and completion**

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

#### **Progression**

In order to progress to the next year, students must obtain confirmation of enrolment and attendance for all subjects in the previous year and have completed a work placement and the following number of credits: for enrolment in the second year, at least 51 credits; for enrolment in the third year, 60 first-year credits and at least 54 second-year credits.

#### **Transitions**

Second-cycle master's study programmes (SQF level 8)

### **Condition for obtaining certificate**

To complete their studies, students must complete all course units in all subjects in which they have enrolled, submit a portfolio of work from their field of study, and prepare and defend a diploma thesis.
