- any completed Bologna first-cycle study programme and completion of any course units from the first-cycle study programme in Music not already completed. Candidates will also be required to pass an entrance examination consisting of the examination material for the final year of the main subject in the first-cycle music programme in the relevant stream.

## Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum

criteria); 5-1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

## Progression

In order to progress to the second year, students must complete all compulsory subjects and course units, for a total of 60 credits.

## Condition for obtaining certificate

To complete their studies, students must complete all course units prescribed by the study programme (120 credits from the curriculum for the chosen stream).
