## Admission requirements

- A completed first-cycle study programme in the same discipline (180 credits); or
- a completed first-cycle study programme in the same discipline (240 credits); in this case up to 60 credits may be recognised, depending on the first-cycle course units completed; or
- any completed first-cycle study programme (180 credits) in another field, if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits; or
- any completed first-cycle study programme (240 credits) in another field, if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits; or
- a completed professional higher education programme under the former programme in another field, if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits.

## Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to:

- develop critical thinking,
- independently acquire knowledge and expertise,
- demonstrate mastery of research methods, procedures and processes,

- communicate orally and in writing at a higher level,
- work as part of a team,
- work autonomously within the discipline,
- pursue lifelong learning in a knowledge-based society,

## Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

## Progression

In order to progress to the second year of the programme, students must have completed course units totalling 90% of the credits prescribed by the curriculum for the individual year (i.e. 54 out of 60 credits).

## Transitions

Third-cycle doctoral study programmes (SQF level 10)

## Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the study programme, students must complete all course units prescribed by the curriculum and individual syllabuses, for a total of 120 credits. In the final year of the programme, students write a relevant master's thesis, which must be successfully defended.
