Admission requirements

- A completed first-cycle two-subject academic higher education programme in the same disciplines (180 credits); or
- a completed first-cycle two-subject academic higher education programme in the same disciplines (240 credits); or
- any other completed first-cycle academic higher education programme in another relevant field (linguistics, social sciences and humanities), if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of 10 to 60 credits; or
- any other first-cycle academic higher education programme in another field, if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits; or
- a completed professional higher education programme under the former programme in relevant fields (linguistics, social sciences and humanities), if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of 10 to 60 credits; or
- a completed professional higher education programme under the former programme in other fields, if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits.

Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to:

- read the most complex Latin literary, specialist and documentary texts,
- autonomously translate literary, specialist and documentary texts from Latin to Slovene and from Slovene to Latin,
- demonstrate in-depth understanding of the synchronic and diachronic aspects of the Latin language,
- demonstrate understanding of the genres, periods, authors and texts of classical Latin and Greek

literature in the broader cultural-historical context,

- define problems of interpretation and interpret texts autonomously,
- undertake autonomous research in the field of Latin language, literature and culture from the synchronic and diachronic perspectives,
- use traditional and modern approaches to textual analysis in a considered manner,
- demonstrate in-depth understanding of the anthropological aspects of ancient and later Latin culture,
- demonstrate in-depth and critical understanding of the reception of ancient culture in various periods and its presence in the contemporary world,
- undertake autonomous academic and professional activity in fields relating to research in Latin language and culture,
- autonomously write research papers and survey articles (articles, textual commentaries; general-interest and journalistic texts), communicate and popularise Latin language, literature and culture,
- undertake autonomous professional development as a researcher and teacher of Latin language, literature and culture.

Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5-1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

In order to progress from the first to the second year of a second-cycle two-subject study programme, students must have completed all course units prescribed by the curriculum and individual syllabuses for the first year, for a total of 60 credits.

Transitions

Third-cycle doctoral study programmes (SQF level 10)

Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the programme, students must complete all course units prescribed by the study programme and individual subject syllabuses, for a total of 60 credits. Since this is a two-subject study programme, in order to complete the overall programme students must also complete all course units in the other discipline, amounting to 60 credits, for a total of 120 credits.
