Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to: (general competences)

- transfer theoretical knowledge into practice,
- apply theoretical knowledge to the resolution of technical and work-related problems,
- seek out new sources of knowledge,

- apply pedagogical theories to the resolution of specific work-related problems.

Assessment and completion

Students' knowledge is assessed by means of practical exercises and seminar papers, and also via products, projects, performances, services, etc. and by examinations. Examination performance is scored as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

A general condition for progression from one year to the next is the completion of at least 54 credits. A further condition for progression is the completion of all practical exercises and all other forms of practical pedagogical training. Students must make up missing credits from a previous year during the following year at the latest.

Transitions

Second-cycle master's study programmes (SQF level 8)

Condition for obtaining certificate

Students complete a two-subject study programme when they have completed all requirements of both parts of the two-subject study programme and thus accumulated at least 180 ECTS credits (90 credits each part of the two-subject study programme).
